Hours of work – 09.30 – 15.30 closure. Road reopens after works. We may work weekends 08.00 – 17.00 if the scheme requires additional hours



What we are doing/the benefits – Northamptonshire Highways will soon start resurfacing works on the A4500 Main Road, Wilby including Doddington Road, Church Lane, Wilby Park Road entrance and Brook Vale.

Works include: Removing the existing carriageway (between the roundabout and 30 signs at Wilby), including junction of Doddington Road and resurfacing along with removing and replacing some kerbs and road studs.

Northamptonshire Highways only close roads when it is absolutely necessary to keep our workforce and road users safe. When we close a road and put a diversion in place we must provide a diversion on a similar standard of road. The diversion route, which will be clearly signed, is chosen to follow roads of a suitable standard and width to carry all traffic. We ask motorists to use this official route so as not to increase the impact on local communities. The diversion can also be viewed on one.network

Information for residents

Please allow extra time for your journey as there may be some delays, dependent on where we are with our works. If you have any concerns or need access, please speak to a member of our team at the closure points during working hours and/or contact the Site Manager for any specific requirements.

Access/egress:

Our team will work with you regarding access. There will be vehicle hold points on the approaches to the works. Once it is safe to access the site, one of our team will escort you through the works. This will be for access only purposes to residents and businesses and there will be no through route for other motorists.

If you require egress from your property and you are <u>outside the working area</u>, please exit slowly and carefully with your hazard warning lights on. Our team will be stationed at closure points to assist. Depending on current works being undertaken you may be asked to follow the diversion in a particular direction.

If you require access/egress to a property <u>directly within the working area</u>, please speak to a member of the site team for assistance. This applies during the temporary traffic light and road closure traffic management.

We will keep you informed and will make every effort to plan access arrangements. Please contact the site manager if you have any specific requirements.

Pedestrians: Pedestrian access will be maintained and pedestrian marshals, identified by their green hats, will be on site to help.


Cyclists: Cyclists will be asked to dismount and use the footways or follow the diversion route.
